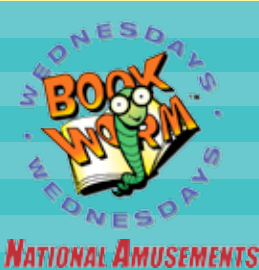
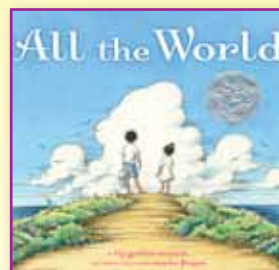

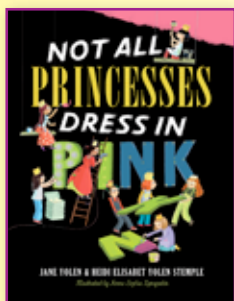
So Brighten Up Your Summer Days with These Books.

All the world is right where you are. Following a circle of family and friends from morning till night, this book reminds us of all things great and small in our world.



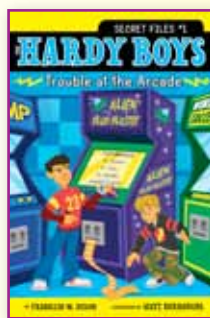
Ages: 3-6, Grades: P-1
These princesses dig in the dirt, kick soccer balls, and splash in muddy puddles—all in their *sparkly crowns!*



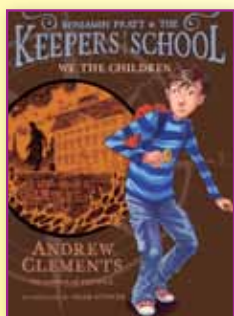
Ages: 4-8, Grades: P-3

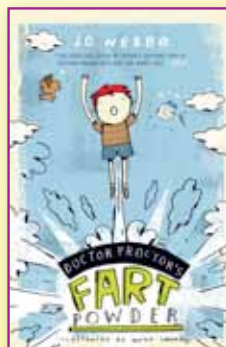
Ages: 7-10, Grades: 2-5
