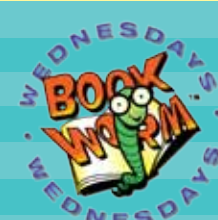
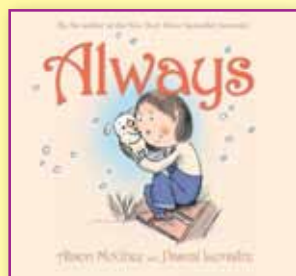

So Brighten up your Summer Days with these Books.



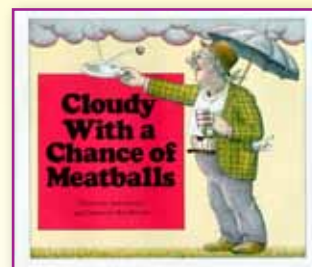
• **Ages 4-8 • Grades: P-3**
How deep is the bond between a child and a beloved dog? So deep that it will bring a pet to protect his dear friend to the ends of the Earth...Always.



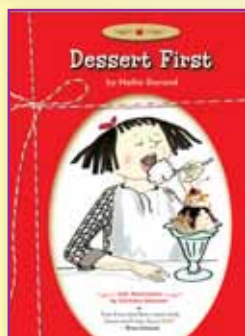
• **Ages: 6-10 • Grades: 1-5**

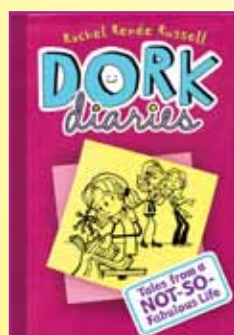
• **Ages: 7-10 • Grades: 2-5**
